 7. Grand Champion Hay Exhibit – Ribbon or Rosette.
 8. Reserve Grand Champion Hay Exhibit – Ribbon or Rosette.

SECTION 3 – SILAGE

1. Silage crop must be named. Exhibits shall consist of one gallon ziplock clear plastic bag for easy transport and display.
