SECTION 2 – HAY

1. Long hay only. An exhibit shall consist of a bale section at least 8 inches thick or an equivalent amount if cut from hay in the mow, and tied (eq. 2 flakes), packaged in a trash bag.

SECTION 3 – SILAGE

1. Silage crop must be named. Exhibits shall consist of one gallon ziplock clear plastic bag for easy transport and display.
