

Requirements:

1. No cattle showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease, including active ring worm, warts, lice and mange, will be admitted to any show.
2. Official CVI (AAI-13) issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry must accompany all cattle for show and sale. No Tuberculosis or Brucellosis test is required for Pennsylvania Cattle.
3. Interstate animals exhibited at Pennsylvania shows or fairs must meet the Pennsylvania requirements and must be accompanied by an interstate health certificate to be eligible for entry. A Tuberculosis test is required. Animals originating from Class A, B or C states must call 717-783-9550 for current requirements for Brucellosis test requirements.
4. All cattle for exhibition in Pennsylvania must be accompanied by a CVI signed by an accredited veterinarian that includes a statement that the animal(s) identified have been immunized against IBR, PI3, BVD & Shipping Fever Complex, using at least 2 doses of killed vaccine, 2-4 weeks apart or one dose of MLV vaccine. The most recent vaccine must be administered not less than 15 days or more than 180 days before the show.
5. Shipping Fever complex is not permitted for animals consigned to slaughter.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Co-Chairmen; to accept the stall assigned without controversy; to keep their animals in an attractive appearance, and to cooperate with the Fair Association in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the show.
2. Decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by animals at shows will be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judges.
3. All animals must be at the fairgrounds on the following days: Junior Dairy Show animals by 9:00 p.m. Sunday; Open Dairy Show animals by 9:00 p.m. Sunday; Dairy Shows, Tuesday, 9:00 a.m. To collect premiums, open class cattle must remain on the grounds until 8:00 p.m. Saturday.
4. **During shows, only 1 class of animals permitted in ring at a time.**
5. The exhibitors will be expected to keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition and to remove all their equipment promptly as the Chairmen may direct, or premium will be forfeited.
6. All dairy animals must be properly registered by their respective dairy breed associations. Registration papers must accompany all animals to the show. All dairy animals shown in group classes must have been shown in their respective individual classes.

1. Junior Best 3 Females – 3 animals under 2 years of age, bred by exhibitor and carrying the same prefix and at least 1 to be owned by exhibitor. **1 entry per exhibitor.** Junior Show – must be bred & owned by exhibitor.

2. Best 3 Females – 3 females, any age, bred by exhibitor and carrying the same prefix and at least 1 to be owned by exhibitor. **1 entry per exhibitor.** Junior Show – Must be bred and owned by exhibitor.

3. Produce Of Dam – 2 animals, any age, any sex and the produce of 1 cow. The dam must be named. Animals need not be owned by same exhibitor.

4. Daughter/Dam – 2 animals, 1 cow & her daughter, any age. Animals need not be owned by 1 exhibitor.

5. Junior Get of Sire – 3 animals under 2 years of age. Need not all be from 1 herd. Not more than 1 bull.

6. Senior Get of Sire – 3 animals 2 years or over. Need not all be from 1 herd.

7. Dairy Herd – 3 cows in milk. All owned by 1 exhibitor. **1 entry per exhibitor.**

8. Best udder – Must be in milk at time of show. **2 entries per exhibitor.**

9. Supreme Champion – 1 Grand Champion from each breed
