HEALTH REGULATIONS

1. An *Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship* (VCPR) form must accompany all PA rabbits, and must be presented

upon arrival at the exhibition.

2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases. Animals appearing unhealthy upon arrival may not enter the grounds.

3. After an animal passes its health examination, then the management will temporarily tag the animal's ear and assign the animal to a cage.

4. Animals do not need permanent tattoos.

5. Any rabbit showing signs of disease or poor health during Fair Week will be placed in a quarantined area & must be removed immediately by exhibitor. These health rules will be strictly enforced.

GENERAL RULES

1. The management will use diligence to ensure the safety of all rabbits after their arrival and placement, but in no case are they responsible for loss or damage.

2. Cages could be re-assigned, if space restrictions require them to be, on the day of arrival – all owners/showers will be notified if this occurs to their animal.

3. All rabbits need to be at least 8 weeks old at the time of the show to be entered for competition.

4. Owners should anticipate having to provide feed for their own animals, but some will be provided by management at the Fair if feed is not available.

5. A reminder of general fair rules regarding passes: In order to purchase a \$5.00 wristband, exhibitor must have a rabbit entry fee of at least \$4.00 or more. Wristbands limited to two, immediate family only.

6. For every rabbit that an owner sells during the fair week, the management will collect a \$1 fee to go towards the further care and upkeep of our department.

7. Entry fee – 75 cents per open class entry.

MEAT RABBIT RULES

1. A Meat Pen consists of 3 rabbits of the same breed and variety (color).

2. All animals in a meat pen must be under 10 weeks old (or 70 days) at the time of the show.

3. Each animal in the meat pen must not weigh over 5 pounds.

4. If one animal in the meat pen is disqualified or eliminated for being overweight (or for any other reason), the whole pen will be eliminated.

5. 4-H meat pens must be the 4-H-er's rabbit project for the current year.

6. Top four placing meat pens will be sold at auction on the Friday of fair week.

PET RABBIT RULES

1. Only one pet entry per exhibitor will be accepted.

2. An animal may only be shown in the pet class if not being shown in any other category.

3. A pet rabbit is a small mixed breed rabbit, the characteristics of which the exhibitor finds appealing.

RABBIT SHOWMANSHIP

1. Only 4-H members may show in the showmanship category.

2. The animal entered must be the 4-H project of and owned by the exhibitor to be entered.

3. The exhibitor must be present to complete in the showmanship category.

4. Judging will be Monday, starting at 2:00 p.m. Please sign up ahead of time for a specific time slot.

CAVIES (Guinea Pigs)

Premiums: First \$3; Second \$2; Third \$1

GENERAL RULES

1. Standard Fair rules and policies apply. Follow health regulations for rabbits.
2. The management will use diligence to ensure the safety of all Cavies after their arrival and placement, but in no case are they responsible for loss or damage.
3. After a Cavy has passed its health examination, the animal will be temporarily tagged and caged for the week.
4. Owners/showers must bring own cages.
5. 4-H exhibitors must have completed 4-H project on entry-entries.
6. The Cavies will be judged immediately following the Rabbit judging in the same location.
7. Age classes are broken down as follows:
 - a. Junior: 0-4 months old & weighing between 12-23 ounces
 - b. Intermediate: 4-6 months old & weighing between 23-32 ounces
 - c. Senior: at least 6 months of age & weighing 33 ounces or more
8. For every Cavy an owner sells during Fair week, the management will collect a \$1 fee to go towards the further care and upkeep of our department.

4-H Club members must have passed their eighth birthday but not have passed their nineteenth birthday by January of the current year. Exhibitors must be 4-H members, carrying a project in the field in which they wish to make entry, and be under the supervision of the Pennsylvania State University Cooperative Extension Service by June 1 preceding the Fair.

ALL JUNIOR EXHIBITORS MUST SIGN & AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE CLARION COUNTY JUNIOR CODE OF PRACTICE.

GENERAL RULES

1. Each item must have been made by a 4-H member who is enrolled in a 4-H project within the current year.
2. Exhibits should portray base requirements as outlined in specific 4-H projects.
3. Pre-registered & additional entries accepted Sunday only, 11:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.
4. All animals must accompany vet/client papers.
5. Rules apply Monday through Friday only.

GOOD HOUSEKEEPING

Good housekeeping will be paid for horses, beef, sheep, swine, goat and dairy. Daily winners will be posted in the barn area and premiums included in checks when issued. All species will be judged on the following guidelines:

- Cleanliness of animals.
- Cleanliness of bedding.
- Entry card and ribbons won properly displayed with animals.
- Keeping grain and hay feed presentable.
- Keeping all equipment neat and sanitary.
