### 2nd Annual Clarion County Fair—Dice Run August 15, 2015 *Rain or Shine*

The route is a trip through 115 miles of scenic Clarion County Pennsylvania. It is the gateway to the PA Wilds. Throughout your trip you will be exposed to a small portion of what is offered in the county to suit almost any ones desire for recreation. From rolling hills and farms to scenic rivers for fishing, canoeing, kayaking, or motor boating to peacefull hiking or bicycling trails spread throughout to beautiful Cook Forest with its "Forest Cathedral" of towering white pines and hemlocks which is a Natural National Landmark.

You will quickly find one or two days is not enough time to take in all we have to offer here.

The Ride Starts at Redbank Valley Municipal Park in Fairmount City, PA with registration opening at 9:45 a.m. and we will head out at 11:00 a.m. Once the event starts, it will conclude no matter of road conditions or weather. You may take any route you choose to get to all the stops and back to the New Bethlehem Moose, 440 Broad Street, New Bethlehem. Here you have a chance to meet up with the other participants, tell stories, have something light to eat and see if you are a winner before heading home. Please remember though you do need to make it to all stops with your dice rolls recorded and authenticated by 4:30 p.m. At that time staff will leave to take roll records to the Moose. Your best five dice rolls will be tallied to arrive at your score. We will throw out your lowest or highest depending on which prize you are closest to. Roll prizes will be awarded at the Moose at 5:15 p.m. You do not have to be present to win. Any tie hand will be broken by rolling the dice and the highest roll wins the tie.

Winners will be notified by Fair representatives. This time schedule will allow ample time to complete the ride at your leisure enjoying the venues at each of the stops. Register at the Clarion County Fair Cruise-In July 26th - 12:00 - 4:00 p.m. And receive a \$5.00 Driver Discount

This event is open to any legally registered and insured vehicle allowed on PA highways.

Please remember this is not a race and you may end your ride at any location. But you must stop at all six locations for your dice rolls to be eligible for the prizes.

Going from the Park to the first suggested location will be escorted front and rear for safety as we expect most participants to go to the stops as suggested. After the first stop you are on your own as we see the group diminishing in size based on the length of time spent at each stop and participants making their own course. Food and or refreshments may be purchased at any of the stops. We have tried to vary the location themes to find something for almost every taste.

A route sheet will be furnished to provide directions from stop to stop, please travel carefully.
